### **Job Purpose:**

This position will de-manufacture and disassemble various electronics, down to the cords, boards, plastics, and steel. This employee should be a fast learner, with a gifting for using his/her hands to take things apart using electric and manual hand tools. This individual must have the ability to learn the differences for the various components.

### **Essential Functions:**

- Able to learn quickly and properly sort various components into proper categories.
- Able to stand for extended periods of time.
- Able to lift 50-75 pounds regularly.
- Work with team members to meet daily and weekly productivity goals - this position is expected to individually disassemble 1,200 pounds of electronics daily.
- Keep work area clean.
- Follow all safety regulations and precautions.

### **Qualifications:**

- Drug free, with pre-employment drug testing.
- Previous experience in electronics disassembly
- Availability to work frequent Saturday events from March-November.
- Ability to lift heavy boxes and items (75-100 pounds).

- Experience with a pallet jack and/or forklift.
